Purpose: Outline hashtag usage guidelines for the World Pancreatic Cancer Coalition/Day

Hashtag	Usage
#WPCD	 Used with any post in relation to the World Pancreatic Cancer Day – either within the text, or at the end Examples: #WorldPancreaticCancerDay is coming up on 11/15 – join us! #WPCD Note: Use in conjunction with #WorldPancreaticCancerDay
#WorldPancreaticCancerDay	 Used with any post in relation to the World Pancreatic Cancer Day – usually within the text Examples: Join us for #WorldPancreaticCancerDay this year on 11/15/2018! #WPCD Note: Use in conjunction with #WPCD
#DemandBetter	 Theme for WPCD 2017 and 2018 (and potentially beyond) – used when it naturally fits in with the messaging for the Day Examples: #DemandBetter for #pancreaticcancer patients this #WPCD. Note: Is not a required hashtag for World Pancreatic Cancer Posts and usage is subject to change pending campaign theme updates
#pancreaticcancer	 Not a branded hashtag but used in almost every post – hashtag pancreatic cancer anytime it is used in social media, so we can join the larger conversation Examples: Do you know the risks & symptoms of #pancreaticcancer?
Other common hashtags: #cancer, #cancerresearch	 Commonly used terms that should also be used as hashtags whenever used on social.
