World Pancreatic Cancer Day will be overseen by a Committee and led by a Chair.

The role of WPCD Committee is to:

- Support the Chair of the Committee to ensure that the WPCD campaign is successfully delivered
- Contribute to the development of WPCD campaign design as required
- Provide timely feedback on campaign developments and proposals
- Support the Committee Chair to ensure that WPCD supporters have access to the information and tools they require to participate in the WPCD campaign
- Ensure that the WPCD campaign is appropriate and relevant for a global audience
- Undertake specific tasks, including review of specific WPCD materials
- Serve as a champion for the campaign locally
- Contribute to the development and implementation of a WPCD evaluation framework

Composition and term

The WPCD Committee will have no more than 10 members including the Chair. In the first cycle, three members will have 1-year terms and 4-members will have 2-year terms. After that, everyone will have 2-year terms. Committee members may serve consecutive terms. The composition of the WPCD Committee should include representation from at least 4 different countries.

The Chair of the Steering Committee will have a 2-year term – subject to nomination and approval of the Steering Committee.

Appointments to the WPCD Committee are made on an individual (vs organizational) basis, but the individual must be a member of a WPCD member organization. Should a WPCD Committee member step down, the role will be open to all Coalition members.

The term of the WPCD Committee members will be February 1 – January 31.

Essential criteria for becoming a member of the Steering Committee:

- Must meet eligibility criteria for Coalition member status (ie not-for profit, patient advocacy organization) and be a confirmed Coalition member.
- Must have experience working with committees/working groups.
- Must be able to participate in WPCD Committee conference calls
- Must be able to contribute to WPCD developments by email between Committee calls.

Desired criteria

- Experience working on large projects and with agencies
