Through global collaboration, members are able to **raise awareness** of pancreatic cancer and **strengthen** the capacity and individual efforts of all member organizations.







Accomplishments 2018

WPCC Annual Meeting 2018



- Held in Coral Gables, FL
- 40 organizations attended, representing 22 countries
- The program, content and venue received approval ratings of 98% - 100%

WPCD 2018

- Almost **1.2 million** total views of all WPCD videos
- More than 849 media placements and **997 million** impressions (a 200% increase from 2017)
- Almost **1.4 million** social media engagements (likes, clicks, comments and shares)
- Google searches for pancreatic cancer-related terms soared!
 - pancreatic cancer month increased 400%
 - pancreatic cancer survival rates increased 250%
 - What are the symptoms of pancreatic cancer increased 100%
- More than **230** landmarks and buildings around the world turned purple
- 38 countries participated (compared to 26 countries in 2017)

- 30+ strategic planning interviews with WPCC members and external representatives

- A WPCC presentation and a scientific poster to showcase the history, initiatives and accomplishments of the Coalition
